How should I take Celtic Wind CBD oil?

We recommend to our customers to take the oil sublingually (under the tongue) for best results.

Can you recommend the most suitable time of day to take the product?

The time of day you should take the product, depends on why you are taking it. Note: We would always recommend you research your particular reason for taking the product to identify the most suitable time of day for your particular needs. Our CBD oil can be taken on its own, with or without food. Again, it depends on the reason why you are taking it.

Can I have an allergic reaction to CBD?

While any food ingredient may cause an allergic reaction, this is extremely rare for a CBD product. In all instances, if you are taking any form of medication, we strongly advise you to seek advice from your medical practitioner before taking our CBD oil. The wide range of components within the oil are also listed in our Multi Complex Datasheet, which is available on our website to download and review.

Can you explain why Celtic Wind CBD oil has different colours and tastes?

Our CBD oil concentrate contains naturally occurring solid compounds from the hemp seed itself. This is an inherent part of the concentration process that retains the complete CBD profile of the product - unlike extracts which remove these compounds to yield a clear oil but also compromise the CBD profile of the finished product. Hence, the different colours and tastes.

Why is Celtic Wind CBD oil so special?

Celtic Wind CBD oil is special because it is a concentrate. When CBD oil is drawn from the plant and bottled for consumption, some brands extract the CBD seed oil from its mother oil and place it in another type of oil for consumption. This is known as an oil extract. During this process, a number of things change in the profile of the oil. A particular acid is also removed, which can

impact / reduce the benefits of the oil within the body. Our oil is different! As a concentrate, we keep our acid phytocannabinoid profile which means our oil will have a greater impact than an extracted oil.

Can I use CBD oil with prescription medicines and other types of medicines?

Celtic Wind CBD oil contains Cannabidiol (CBD) which is a safe, non-intoxicating and non-addictive hemp compound with no reported contraindications at the recommended dose. While any food ingredient may cause an allergic reaction, this is extremely rare for a CBD product. In all instances, we would recommend to customers to download the Multi Complex Datasheet and discuss taking our CBD oil with their medical practitioner first if they are taking medication.

Can you explain the difference between CBD and THC - there is a lot of confusion out there?

There is confusion between CBD and THC because both are cannabinoids and both are frequently used in the same context in various media reports. THC is a controlled psychoactive substance that is regulated as a medicine by law. CBD is non-psychoactive and it is not a controlled substance. CBD is sold as a food supplement, and is legally recognised as such under the Food Supplements Directive.

Our CBD oil is a recognised food supplement and contains 100% natural food ingredients derived from the hemp plant. In accordance with the EU Directive for food supplements, our product carries a Food Safety Authority of Ireland (FSAI) notification number and can be sold throughout Europe. Our CBD oil is also supplied as a food supplement in accordance with the provisions of Article 2 of the EU Food Supplement Directive 2002/46/EC.
